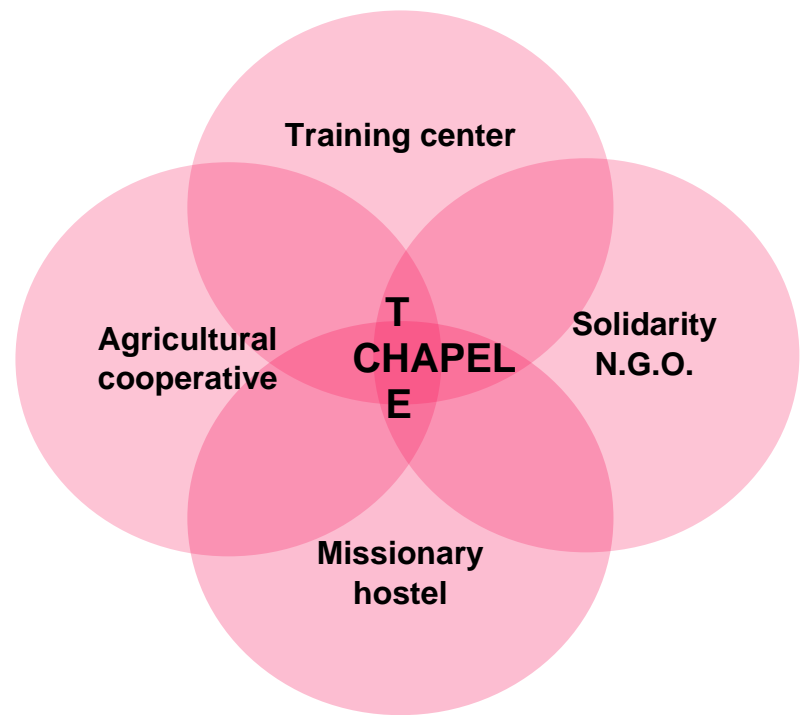

Have you ever noticed that, according to the book of Revelation (chapter 6, verse 6) in the end times oil and wine are a wise investment? Have you ever wondered how it will be possible to buy food without accepting the mark of the Beast? Have you ever thought about how we will be able to gather during times of persecution of the Church?

We believe that a reformation needs to happen in the Church, leading to a rythm of life that connects us more with God and with our fellow believers, so that we can be salt and light to our societies. We want to seize economic opportunities in this times of crisis, investing in the right properties, developing an ecological and financial sustainable model. Starting with some trials, we aim at connecting these places across the Mediterranean, like a fishing net.

### CLUSTER'S ELEMENTS

- 1 The chapel. The motor and the connector of the whole project.**

A place for Christian fellowship, common to all the cluster's elements, where intercession and worship are going on unceasingly, where we can meet God, personally and corporately, where we minister to Him and to each other. A place where the Spirit of the Lord moves mightily.
- 2 Agricultural cooperative. A foundational element, the actual farm.**

Similar to a kibbutz or a modern monastery, we want to cultivate the presence of God as well as the nature He created for us. This is the place for gardening, farming and distribution of the products. Any benefit of our work is to be reinvested inside the Cluster or its Network, so that we can have the status of a Social Solidarity Enterprise.
- 3 Training center. A gift to the Body of Christ and to the local community.**

A private school specialized in "Lifelong Learning Education". A place where to organize Christian training programs for interns and conferences to empower the members of the network and local people (spirituality, agriculture, fishing, tourism management, cooking, arts, music, foreign languages, ecology, sustainable development, etc.).
- 4 Solidarity NGO. A great way to interact with the society's institutions.**

Designed to receive public support and to help with fundraising (festivals, calls for projects). The aim is to facilitate social inclusion of people in need (refugees, drug addicts, prostitutes), to recruit, manage and redistribute local or international volunteers, to promote and support campaigns in defence of the persecuted Christians in the Med.
- 5 Missionary hostel. Warm and cozy, a place where to practice hospitality.**

A building or a camping site with the status of a social enterprise, responsible for the invitation of missionaries and refugees families through solidarity programs, for the reception of «solidarity tourists» and for hosting groups during the community events.
